Course Overview

This qualification has been designed primarily for post-16 learners who wish to achieve a Level Entry 3 qualification in preparation for future study. The qualification has been designed to meet explicitly the needs of this group of learners in terms of content, assessment and progression. The purpose of BTEC Entry to Vocational Study qualifications is to support learners' skill development in preparation for higher-level learning, therefore increasing opportunities for learners to progress.

Learners study one mandatory unit (Skills for Learning) and two optional units. The current optional units are Customer Services and Communication, but these may change with each cohort.
